Munali Nickel Mine under goes recapitalization by the Consolidated Nickel Mines of UK

Recapitalization is the process of restructuring a company's debt and equity mixture, often to make a company's capital structure more stable. The process essentially involves the exchange of one form of financing for another, such as removing preferred shares from the company's capital structure and replacing them with bonds. In other words, it is basically the strategy a company uses to improve its financial stability or overhaul its financial structure



Anton Mauve the Chief Executive Officer said that in order to accomplish this, the company must change its debt to equity ratio. This is done by adding more debt or more equity to its capital. There are many reasons why a company may consider to undergo recapitalization this includes; to reduce financial obligations and minimize taxes, to provide venture capitalists with an exit strategy and Bankruptcy etc.

When a company's debt decreases in proportion to its equity, it has lower leverage. Its earnings per share (EPS) should decrease following the change. But its shares would be incrementally less risky since the company has fewer debt obligations, which require interest payments and return of principal upon maturity. Without the requirements of debt, the company can return more of its profits and cash to shareholders. (Anton Mauve-CEO)

Or -15.9 and 28.1 (In decimal degrees). Its UTM position is PC 14 and its joint operation graphic reference is SD35-15.
